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#### **PURPOSE**

The Education Program is to promote quality education for children – especially for military children – and adults

## **DEADLINES/IMPORTANT DATES**

- March 1st: National scholarship **online applications** must be submitted.
- March 1st: Students submit Department scholarship applications to Unit President for review and certification.
- March 15<sup>th</sup>: Units select ONE scholarship application for each national scholarship category and forward it to the Department Chairman.
- April 1st: Submit Education Award cover sheet with narrative for judging as Most Outstanding Unit Education Program to the Department Chairman. (See question to answer; 1,000 words or less.)
- To be considered for a national award, the unit must submit their entry with a National Award cover sheet to the Department Chairman. The National Award cover sheet is included in this packet.
- April 15th: Purple Up! Day for Military Children.

#### **GET INVOLVED**

- 1. Promote quality education for children and adults:
  - Participate in the Give 10 to Education Program.
  - Participate in American Education Week, November 18-22, 2024.
  - Participate in Teachers Appreciation Week, May 5-9, 2025.
  - Encourage schools to participate in Month of the Military Child and Purple Up! Day in April to honor students who are military children.
    - o Sponsor a Purple Up! Day on April 15<sup>th</sup> in your school by providing purple items for students to wear.
    - Present the Military Child Table at your school, unit meeting, or Post [Military Child's Table Setting Ceremony].
- 2. Work with your Legion Post to encourage schools to invite veterans to speak in their classrooms.
- 3. Support and promote the Education Program and scholarship opportunities of The American Legion Family.
- 4. Provide Unit scholarships for students.
- 5. Encourage female members of the American Legion Auxiliary who are pursuing a higher education to apply for **M. Louise Wilson Educational Loans** (www.amlegionauxwi.org/scholarships).
- 6. Donate to the M. Louise Wilson Educational Loan Fund. (**Citation will be given** at Dept. Convention to Unit, County and District donating the most to the M. Louise Wilson Educational Loan Fund.)
